Modification Requests in Housing: **Verification Letters** -What are reasonable accommodations

in housing? If their housing is inaccessible, people

with disabilities may ask their housing providers for changes in the rules, policies, procedures, or services to meet their disability-related needs. These are called reasonable accommodations

-What is a verification letter? Verification letters are used to support a resident's reasonable accommodation/modification requests. A verification letter confirms that a

person with a disability has a disabilityrelated need for the change they are requesting to their housing policies, procedures, services, or physical structures. To get a sample verification click the link:




